Summer School Classes for 8th graders

Summer school enrollment forms are available in the office for current 8th graders. Session #1 is from June 7-June 28th. Session #2 is from July 5 – 26th. Both sessions are from 7:30 am – 12:15 pm and are held at Memorial High School. Transportation is available and must be requested by signing up and paying for summer school BY MAY 4, 2012. Payment MUST be received at the time of enrollment for summer school. Classes are \$75.00 for full pay students or \$15 for students receiving free/reduced lunches.
